Project Porchlight British Columbia, thanks to funding from the EnCana Corporation and BC Hydro, has set a goal to distribute one energy efficient light bulb to each home in North Eastern British Columbia. We need your help to bring Project Porchlight to your community!

We are currently seeking **Field Representatives** (hourly contract) in your community. This is a 12 week term position at an hourly rate of \$15.00/hour.

You will be responsible for implementing the day to day, door to door field delivery of CFL bulbs to designated households. Major responsibilities also include data collection and reporting as well as public education and outreach. You will supervise volunteers and assist in the coordination of events. Evening and weekend work will be required.

**Skills Required:** ability to work under pressure with excellent attention to detail; ability to meet daily and weekly delivery targets; ability to work in a team environment with little supervision; excellent interpersonal and social skills; physical ability to hand-delivery bulbs in all types of residential settings with varying levels of accessibility.

You will help us:

- Create awareness about Compact Fluorescent Light bulbs (CFLs) and energy efficient behaviours in your community
- Coordinate bulb distribution in communities
- Coordinate volunteers and supplies for community events
- Assist with the implementation of activities and publicity events
- Foster strong relationships with community sponsors and volunteers
- Support volunteer recruitment, training, activities and recognition
- Deliver CFLs to designated households and neighbourhoods

Project Porchlight is a community-based social marketing campaign administered by One Change, a not-for-profit organization based in Ottawa that encourages the adoption of environmentally conscious behaviours.
